The tradition began when a group of bold children walked up to the White House gate, hoping to be allowed to play egg-rolling games there. President Hayes told his guards to let the children enter, and soon Easter Monday on the White House grounds became an annual tradition. But recently the White House canceled its upcoming annual Easter Egg Roll because of the coronavirus outbreak. Even the Easter Bunny has to socially distance himself now. But the good news is that Easter has not been cancelled! In just a few days we will be entering Holy Week. Some twenty years after the resurrection of Christ, Paul wrote to the Philippians:


