

Discussion & Reflection Questions

Sermon: "Keeping His Word," Genesis 50

Main Point: As we keep God's Word by acting on His promises, we live as kingdom people who are aware of His larger purposes.

Discussion/Reflection Questions:

Sunday:

Reflect on the fact that just like Joseph, your own life can be a powerful testimony when you act on God's past, present, and future promises. This week, let this be your daily prayer: "God, in all that I do today, my top priority is keeping Your Word!"

Monday:

Read Genesis 50:1-14. In what sense is Joseph keeping God's Word by burying his father Jacob back in the land of Canaan? What is one way that you have sought to live out a promise that God has given to you in the past?

Tuesday:

Read Genesis 50:15-21. In what sense is Joseph keeping God's Word by the way he treats his brothers? What stands out to you about the brothers' perspective vs. Joseph's perspective, and what lesson can you draw from this?

Wednesday:

Read Genesis 50:22-26. How do Joseph's words in verse 24 turn out to be prophetic in terms of the future events that will one day follow? During his 110 years of life, what stands out to you the most about the testimony of Joseph's life?

Thursday:

Reflect on Pastor Doug's final 3 points:

- Keeping God's Word means living out His Word (1 John 2:3-5)
- Keeping God's Word causes us to be fruitful (Luke 8:15)
- Keeping God's Word makes us people of promise (2 Peter 1:3-4)

What are some practical steps you can take to keep God's Word in the coming weeks?

Friday:

Spend quality time with the Lord in prayer, thanking Him for all that you've learned from the testimony of Joseph's life. Ask Him for the wisdom and strength to faithfully keep God's Word, that the testimony of your own life might impact others around you.
